This Red Point tournament for the KZNBU Teams and Pairs Championships is played over 6 sessions from Friday morning to Sunday afternoon (9 August 2019 to 11 August 2019). Only paid up members of the SABF may participate. No meals will be provided but sufficient time will be allowed for people to go out for lunch on the three days. Players are invited to bring picnic lunches on those days. Teas will be provided.

- WHEN:** Friday 9 August 2019 (2 sessions; Teams Morning 9-12.30; Afternoon 1.30-5.00)
Saturday 10 August 2019 (2 Sessions; Teams Morning 9-12.30; Pairs Afternoon 1.30-5.00)
Sunday 11 August 2019 (2 Sessions; Pairs Morning 9-12.30; Afternoon 1.30-5.00)
- WHERE:** Clarence Road Primary School.
- COST:** R800 per Team and R400 per Pair. Players may play in both or just one of the segments (Teams and Pairs) but there is no discount for entering both.
- PARKING:** On the top field off 5th Avenue
