Notice to all **LADIES** who are affiliated to the KZN Bridge Union

The **South African Women's Bridge Association (SAWBA)** hosts an annual tournament.

The next SAWBA will be held in PRETORIA during FEB / MARCH 2019. And ALL lady Members are encouraged to play in the Open Events. (See Details on SABF Website)

Before the Open Pairs and Open Teams Events, the Tournament starts with the Inter-Provincials on 28th February and 1st March 2019.

The trials for the teams to represent KZN are scheduled for 2 full days Thursdays 11th and 18th October 2018 at the Durban Jewish Centre , Durban. The Committee of the KZN Bridge Club are the convenors of the Trials.

Each province is entitled to send an **A and B Team and a "Development" team.**

A Team: This is Open to all Ladies and we expect the experienced players to be contesting for a place in this team. There are no limitations.

B Team: The team qualifying to play in this section may not have a combined total of more than 1500 PI's.

(PI = Performance Index for each individual which can be found on the SABF Web Site.)

Pritchard Team: (C Team)

This third team is also limited by total PI's (400 for the Team) and the intention is to encourage newer players to contest in this section to gain experience in more serious competition.

All Lady members of the KZNB who can commit to playing in Pretoria on the given dates are invited to enter.

Trials for the A Team will be in TEAMS Format. Choose your Team if possible, else enter as a pair and, with consultation, we will match you with another pair.

Depending on the number of entries and the PI Combinations, the Convenors will decide whether the Trials format for the B and C Teams will be in Teams or Pairs. Again depending on numbers entering, the Convenors reserve the right to combine the trials or play them in separate sections, or indeed to select one or more of the teams.

The cost to play for the 2 days will be R200 per person.
